





MASTERING THE AUDIT OF EVENT SUSTAINABILITY MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (ESMS) BASED ON ISO 20121, IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF ISO 19011 AND ISO 17021

SUMMARY

This five-day intensive course enables the participants to develop the necessary expertise to audit an Event Sustainability Management System (ESMS) as specified in ISO/IEC 20121 and to manage a team of auditors by applying widely recognized audit principles, procedures and techniques. During this training, the participant will acquire the necessary knowledge and skills to proficiently plan and perform internal and external audits in compliance with ISO 19011 and ISO 17021. Based on practical exercises, the participant will develop the skills (mastering audit techniques) and competencies (managing audit teams and audit program, communicating with customers, conflict resolution, etc.) necessary to efficiently conduct an audit.

Domain 5: Conduct of an ISO 20121 audit

Main Objective: To ensure that the ISO 20121 Lead Auditor candidate can conduct efficiently an ESMS audit in the context of ISO 20121

Domain 6: Conclusion and follow-up of an ISO 20121 audit

Main Objective: To ensure that the ISO 20121 Lead Auditor candidate can conclude an ESMS audit and conduct follow-up activities in the context of ISO 20121

Domain 7: Management of an ISO 20121 audit program

Main Objective: To ensure that the ISO 20121 Lead Auditor understands how to establish and manage an ESMS audit program
